Professional Service Fees

Range from \$3400 - \$6,400

Scope of services included in this fee

In the spirit of transparency, a further explanation about our professional service fee is provided below. For most funerals in our care, our professional service fee is made up of the following 4 components. In circumstances where we are honouring a request for no ceremony or gathering, the professional service fee will only include components 1, 2 & 3. Our Professional Service Fee incorporates all the tasks and services involved in arranging and co-ordinating. This may include but is not limited to the following.

1. F. Greed & Sons expertise, skill, care and attention, and necessary overhead costs: (\$2,480)
This component includes but is not limited to consultation with the family; guidance, care and advice from experienced, professionally trained staff – administrative, co-ordination and clerical services; preparation, filing and accounts, preparation and lodgement of the registration of the death; a proportionate cost share for the provision and maintenance of necessary premises and equipment; maintenance of specialty vehicles e.g mortuary transfer vehicles and hearse; compliance with current workplace health and safety requirements; ongoing training and development of our staff; telephone, electricity, gas, rates, taxes and insurances; workers compensation, compulsory superannuation; and standby and penalty rates for the availability of a 24 hour workforce.

2. Co-ordinating, Mortuary transfer vehicle & staff and Mortuary facilities: (\$720)
Managing the local Transfer of the deceased into our care at any hour of any day:
(An additional charge will apply for Flat Fee, after hours/, weekends / public holidays, and travel. Transfer fees are listed under additional Service & fees.
Please note: Where it becomes apparent after engagement that our services are limited to transfer-only, a supplementary mortuary care fee will apply.
The fee will be determined once documentation requirements, timeframe, and collection arrangements are clarified, and is generally within the range of **\$620 to \$800**. Including 3 days of mortuary storage

3. All necessary preparation and care of the deceased in our mortuary care centre:
Range from **\$485 - \$720** Mortuary rendering of hygienic preparation and care.
Depending on the level of professional care required or requested.

4. Facilitating funeral ceremony: As an average **(\$1,800)**, however this fee can range from **\$1,760 - \$2,760** This component of the professional service fee is based on the provision of funeral personnel required for the organisation and facilitation of viewings, ceremony and/or gatherings at the chosen location and where applicable funeral personnel for overseeing these arrangements and attending to all the needs on those days and managing the ceremony. Use of the F. Greed & Sons facility and equipment as chosen or required.

Costs outside of the Professional Service Fee;

Audio-visual Services, catering services, cemetery equipment, coffin/casket as selected or urns, payments on client's behalf: e.g. cemetery or cremation fees, flowers, funeral notices, clergy, celebrant & musician fees, audio visual hire for external venues, third party venue fees, certified copy of death certificate. After hour fees for ceremonies held at night, on public holidays or on weekends.

Essential Care Service

(No Funeral Service)

A basic service fee used to assist families. Inclusive of mortuary care, funeral arrangements during weekdays, completion of all necessary permits, certificates and documentation for cremation, and application for the death certificate. No funeral or mourners in attendance. No viewing. Transfer cost to be advised on location. Coffins selection range in price list.

(Please note: third party disbursements are not included in our Essential Care Service Fee and will add to the total cost)*
