

Robyn's Hedgehog Slice Recipe

½ pkt crushed Marie Biscuits (some finely crushed and some bigger pieces)
½ pkt crushed Chocolate Ripple biscuits. Not too fine.
125 grams butter
½ tin Condensed Milk (NOT skim milk)
1 ½ tablespoons cocoa (Plaistowe Dutch cocoa in a tin is best) 😊
¼ teaspoon vanilla essence
½ cup chopped walnuts
¾ cup of combined dried cranberries and glace cherries
¼ cup shredded coconut

Melt butter and condensed milk in a medium size saucepan over gentle heat, add cocoa and vanilla and stir well.

Stir in walnuts, cranberries/cherries & shredded coconut.

Stir in crushed biscuits and mix until all combined and nicely coated in chocolate mixture.

Spoon into a greased slice tin or ideally a container that measures ~ 24 x 19 cms and press well. Smooth out top.

Chocolate top: I always use CADBURYS Dark Cooking Chocolate 45% (this makes all the difference!)

Melt cooking chocolate and 1 tablespoon of Copha (some people dispute whether this is necessary, it's essential!) in a microwave safe small bowl. 2 mins is usually enough. Stir chocolate and copha together until a good poring consistency and pour over hedgehog. Decorate with sprinkles or more shredded coconut as desired and refrigerate until set.
